

# Privacy Statement for Clients



Primo Marine Group B.V. and all its subsidiaries and affiliates (hereafter, "Primo Marine") processes personal data of (potential) clients and other persons with whom Primo Marine maintains contact as part of or related to its services (hereafter, "you").

This Privacy Statement explains how Primo Marine manages personal data.

## **1** Use of personal data by Primo Marine

**1.1**  
All personal data processed by Primo Marine is dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the relevant legislation and may be processed by Primo Marine in the various jurisdictions in which Primo Marine operates.

**1.2**  
In connection with the services provided and yet to be provided to clients (in the broadest sense), Primo Marine may have in its possession personal data relevant to its providing of these services. Primo Marine requires this personal data for the purposes of the services it provides to you. This may, for example, concern personal data which Primo Marine requires at the outset.

**1.3**  
Primo Marine may also require personal data to carry out substantive work on your behalf in accordance with your instructions. This data may have been obtained from you or from other sources (such as, but not limited to, public sources and other parties involved in the case).

**1.4**  
Primo Marine also processes your personal data to share industry knowledge and expertise through newsletters or send invitations to a knowledge-sharing or other event. These concerns (business) contact data (such as the email address where you can be reached). If you are not yet our client, Primo Marine request your consent for this purpose.

## **2.** Disclosure of personal data to third parties

**2.1**  
Primo Marine may disclose to third parties' personal data made available to it. Primo Marine does if this is necessary in order to discharge your instructions and/or for the purposes of our internal business operations.

**2.2**  
Primo Marine must also comply with its legislative obligations to provide information to third parties, for example to regulatory, tax and custom authorities.

**2.3**  
All third parties have their own responsibility to comply with the privacy legislation. Primo Marine is not responsible or liable for the care – or lack of care – taken by these third parties in processing your personal data or for any resulting loss or damage.

**2.4**  
Where a third party (such as an IT supplier) processes personal data on its behalf, Primo Marine will have concluded a contract with that third party under which the processing of the personal data is carried out in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

## **3** Primo Marine website and your privacy

**3.1**  
When you visit the website of Primo Marine your IP address is automatically logged. The logged data are kept on the web server for a limited number of days.

**3.2**  
Primo Marine's website uses cookies to improve the users experience while visiting the website. Where applicable Primo Marine's website uses a cookie control system allowing the user on their first visit to the website to allow or disallow the use of cookies on their computer / device.

**3.3**  
Primo Marine may also require personal data to carry out substantive work on your behalf in accordance with your instructions. This data may have been obtained from you or from other sources (such as, but not limited to, public sources and other parties involved in the case).

## **4** Retention periods

**4.1**  
Primo Marine holds your personal data for no longer than necessary and/or for the purposes of regulatory compliance.

Primo Marine has taken appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure the security of your personal data.
